Private and secure: Dedicated to your connection only, protecting your mission-critical data traffic. You are able to configure and use the Leased Line service in any way, subject to complying with UK regulations.

Nationwide coverage: Depending upon your bandwidth requirements, a Leased Line variant will reach the whole UK, providing the widest reach of any data service. The highest speed circuits are priced and are available depending upon distance.

Pricing

Leased Line pricing is simple to understand. There is a connection charge which covers the Cisco router, other equipment, managed installation and connection of your service.

Suggested back up options are SDSL and ADSL. These services will have a one off connection fee and annual rental charge depending upon the speed of the circuit. There is also the option of an ISDN back up circuit which can be provided at a lower cost if included in the original installation. There is no rental charge for the ISDN circuit.

Annual rental will vary by your chosen bandwidth.

- One off connection charge, varies by bandwidth
- Annual rental, varies by bandwidth and distance from network
- Optional ADSL back up circuit, connection fee and annual rental
- Optional SDSL back up circuit, connection fee and annual rental
- Optional ISDN back up circuit, one off charge

Back up options

Resiliency is important to our customers and a back up circuit is now standard practice. We recommend an SDSL circuit as the ideal back up to the higher speed Leased Line services. In the event of a network fault, your circuit will fail over to a 2Mbps symmetrical DSL circuit so that business critical traffic such as email can continue to be delivered.

ADSL and ISDN are also provided as back up options and are ideal for the lower speed end of the Leased Line portfolio.

Service coverage

In the UK, Easynet owns one of the most extensive fibre optic networks in the UK at 6030Km with 62 core network Points of Presence (PoPs) and 1,176 Network access points. This covers over 70% of UK homes and businesses.

Easynet's network encompasses the UK, France, Germany, Belgium, Holland and Spain. Each Easynet operation has its own network centres, hosting and colocation facilities, national peering arrangements and international connectivity.
